

International University Scholarship Application

Incoming international freshmen and transfer applicants only

To apply for Eastern Oregon University Scholarship opportunities, you must submit a complete application for admission in addition to completing the personal statement as outlined in this section. This application is valid only for students entering EOU in the Fall of the 2009-10 academic year. Scholarships are offered on a competitive basis based on the date of application, GPA, strength of high school or college courses completed, demonstrated participation and activities, and potential contribution to the educational and campus goals of Eastern Oregon University. Information in the scholarship application will not affect your admission to EOU.

The International Tuition Waiver Scholarship rewards international students with exceptional records of academic achievement and who have made contributions to their communities. Awards range from \$500 - \$1,500 for the 2009-10 academic year. Awards are highly competitive. Scholarships will be renewable for up to 12 terms of undergraduate coursework provided you earn a minimum of 45 credit hours per year with a 2.5 cumulative EOU grade point average.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Must be post-marked or delivered to the Office of Admissions by 5:00pm February 1, 2009. Only complete applications will be considered.

Scholarship Essay (required for all applicants to be considered)

Please explain how you hope to achieve your education and career goals by attending EOU, the contributions you have made in your surrounding community, and the contributions you hope to make to our educational community.

To be considered for this scholarship, you must meet the following guidelines:

- Essays must be typed, edited and spell-checked and are limited to 500 words
- Put your full name on the top right-hand corner of each page
- Enclose a resume of activities, involvement and recognition
- All scholarship materials must be clearly marked as "Scholarship Application"
- Submit a complete application for admission (see admission requirements)
- Applications for scholarship and admission must be postmarked or received by the Office of Admissions February 1, 2009 by 5:00pm Pacific Standard Time.

Note: Additional information such as photos, newspaper clippings, and copies of previous awards or recognition will not be used in scholarship decisions, and will be destroyed.
