S/U OPTION POLICY:

The purpose of the S/U option is to encourage you to take courses outside your major program without fear of the grade earned affecting your GPA.

The S/U grading option must be elected by the second Friday of the term. To elect the S/U option, this form is to be filed with the Registrar's Office. Of the 180 term hours required for the bachelor's degree, you may elect up to 36 for S/U (courses offered only on an S/U basis are not included in the 36-hour limit). The grade of "S" indicates a grade comparable to a grade of "C-" or better.

The S/U option **MAY NOT** be elected for any course used to meet specific program requirements unless contrary to the policy of the school offering the course.

If you have questions regarding courses which can be taken for S/U, see your program adviser.

If you are repeating a course to raise a grade, a grade of "U" is not considered to be a higher grade than a "D" or "F".
