#### I. Institutional Graduation Requirements:

\_\_\_\_\_ Complete a minimum of 180 credit hours. Up to 120 credit hours of lower division transfer course work may be applied to the degree.

\_\_\_\_\_ Earn an Eastern GPA of at least 2.000 and a composite GPA of 2.000. A transfer GPA and the Eastern GPA are combined at the time of graduation.

\_\_\_\_\_ Complete a minimum of 60 credit hours of upper - division coursework (300-400 level).

\_\_\_\_\_ Complete all requirements in the major, including at least 35 credit hours, 25 of which must be 300 or 400 level courses. Of these, a minimum of 20 must be from EOU of which 10 must be upper division.

\_\_\_\_\_ Complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from EOU of which 30 must be upper division.

\_\_\_\_\_ A maximum of 90 credit hours in one discipline may be applied to the B.S. or the B.A. degree.

\_\_\_\_\_ Complete a minimum 3-credit college-level math/stat course (see catalog for details).

\_\_\_\_\_ Complete college-level foreign language requirement for B.A. (see catalog)

\_\_\_\_\_ Complete General Education Core with a C- or better. (Minimum of 60 credits, see catalog)

\_\_\_\_\_ Up to 12 credit hours in PE activity courses, up to 12 credit hours in music activity courses, and up to 12 credit hours in INTACT courses (Music majors may exceed the MUS limitation).

\_\_\_\_\_ Up to 45 credit hours of practicum coursework may be applied to the degree.
