

## LIBERAL STUDIES (LS) MAJOR

<b>Program Outcomes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Acquire a solid foundation in the two core disciplines included in the Liberal Studies degree.</li> <li>- Comprehend the differences in perspective and methods between the two core disciplines.</li> <li>- Develop skills in research, writing, and presenting across the two disciplines.</li> </ul> <p><i>Prior to deciding on the LS major, you should discuss your reasoning with academic advisers in the minors or subject fields in which you are interested.</i></p>
<b>LS Degree Options</b>	<p>Options involve combining <b>two or more study areas</b> into a unified degree program.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Two EOU Minors (Option most often selected)</li> <li>• Preapproved Programs: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>---Business and Health Promotion</li> <li>---Organizational Psychology (new Fall 2009)</li> <li>---Early Childhood Education</li> <li>---Environmental Studies</li> <li>---Gender Studies/Business (available only on-campus)</li> <li>---Small City and Rural County Management Program</li> </ul> </li> <li>• One EOU minor and one minor from another accredited institution</li> <li>• Individualized Program (featuring two subject fields or a subject field/minor)</li> </ul>
<b>LS Major Checklist</b>	<p>Review <a href="#">Liberal Studies major checklist</a></p>
<b>LS Adviser Selection</b>	<p>Upon admittance to EOU, you will be assigned to an adviser. Find your <a href="#">academic adviser</a>:</p>
<b>LS Program Admission Process</b>	<p>Select the LS option that is best suited for you and discuss with your adviser. The ideal time to seek admission to the Liberal Studies Major is when you have completed 60 or more quarter hours.</p> <p><b>ON CAMPUS:</b></p> <p><b>Two EOU Minors option</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Download your desired <a href="#">Minor check sheets</a>.</li> <li>• Ask faculty members in each of the two minors to serve as your LS Program Advisers.</li> <li>• Print and complete the <a href="#">Liberal Studies Major Two Minors Admission Form</a></li> <li>• Turn the form into the Advising Office at Inlow 105. Your program will be evaluated for program admission approval. You and your advisers will receive a letter stating if you have been fully or conditionally admitted to the LS program.</li> </ul> <p><b>Preapproved Program, One EOU/One Other Minor from an accredited institution, or the Individualized Program Options</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Contact <a href="#">Mary Koza</a>, Director of Liberal Studies Program Review, Hunt Hall B308, or call (541) 962-3475 to make an appointment.</li> <li>• Note that the EOU Liberal Studies Committee must approve program admission for the LS options of One EOU/One Other Minor from an accredited institution and Individualized Programs.</li> </ul>

	<p><b>Off-campus:</b> Contact your online adviser to select your LS degree option and file your LS Admit to Program.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Print and complete the <a href="#">Liberal Studies Major Two EOU Minors admission form for online students</a> and <a href="#">Liberal Studies Template</a></li> </ul>
<b>Program Completion</b>	Check with your LS Program Advisers as you progress in completing your degree plan. Get an adviser's approval for course substitutions.
<b>Capstone</b>	<p><b>ON CAMPUS:</b> Go to <a href="#">Capstone Liberal Studies Proposal for On Campus Majors</a> for instructions on completing LS 401 Arts and Sciences, LS 402 Business, or LS 403 Education (your Liberal Studies Capstone) unless your adviser recommends another capstone course that meets your specific goals.</p> <p><b>OFF-CAMPUS:</b> Go to <a href="#">Capstone Options for online majors including Liberal Studies</a></p>
<b>Apply for Graduation</b>	<p>At least two terms or a year before graduation, complete a Graduation Application.</p> <p><b>On Campus:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pick up Graduation Application and Recognition of Minor forms from the Registrar's Office.</li> <li>• Select one of your LS Program Advisers to assist you with your Graduation Application. Make an appointment with this adviser. Bring your current transcript, completed Graduation Application, and a signed Recognition of Minor form for each minor that you wish to have listed on your transcript.</li> <li>• Turn all completed forms into the Registrar's Office <b>on or before the specified deadline (the second Friday of the term before you will graduate).</b></li> </ul> <p><b>Off-campus:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Contact your online Academic Adviser to arrange to file your Graduation Application.</li> </ul>
