



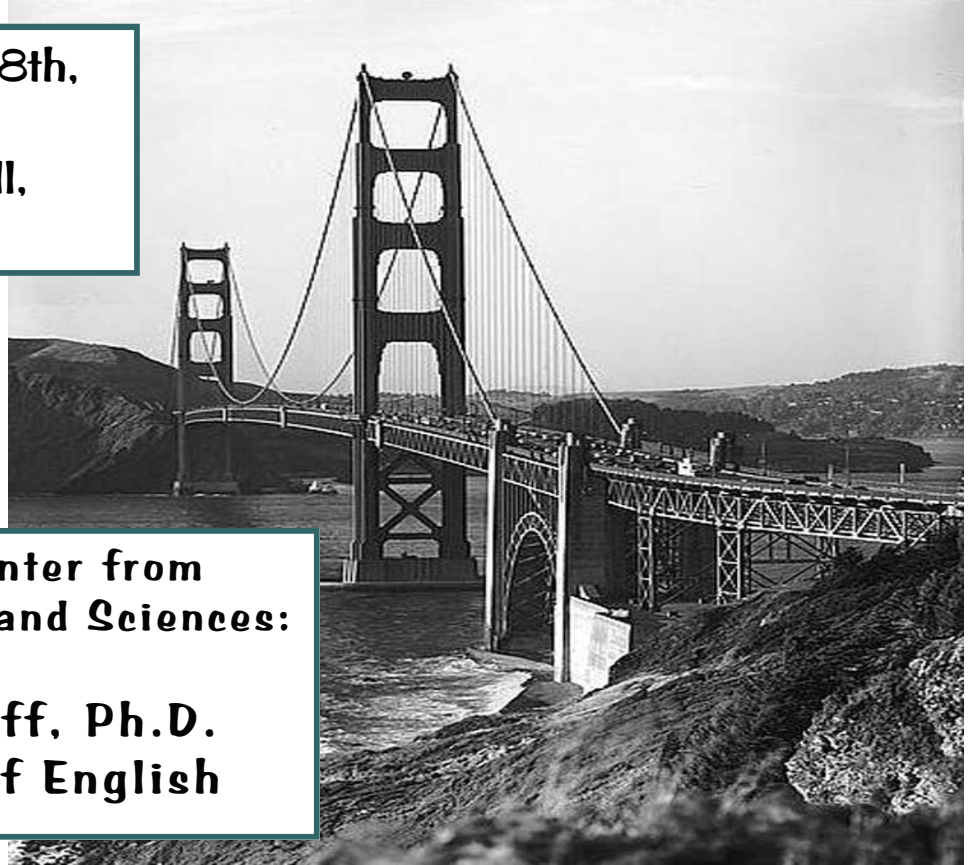

The Mysteries of Poetic Inquiry: The Recondite Processes of Poetry Composition Revealed for All!

Prof. Wolff will explore the generation of one of his poems, "In the Way of the World," from his new manuscript, *What's Close to Me*. To analyze the production of the poem, Wolff will employ Eastern's lenses of inquiry—the central, self-generated question leading to deeper understanding, the poetic method with close attention to form and tradition, the technology of poem writing as represented in the processes of composing, and even the use of relevant research to enhance the project. In addition to exploring the nature of inquiry, the presentation promises to uncover some of the mysteries of poetry writing.
