The Modern Language and Global Cultures program at EOU offers a two-year certificate degree in Spanish for Health Care Professionals. The program is intended to provide special skills to people who are already working or intend to work in the health care industry. The objective of the certificate is to provide the necessary skills to communicate in Spanish at an intermediate level in situations typically encountered in the health care industry. The coursework for the certificate is a combination of online and onsite instruction. For the online component, students work at their computer. The onsite component is face-to-face instruction on a full weekend meeting scheduled once per term.
