Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT)

The Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) program is a 13 month, graduate teacher preparation program leading to an initial teaching license. The MAT program is designed for students who have a baccalaureate degree and wish to teach at the elementary or secondary level. Master of Science in Education (MS)

The Master of Science degree (MS) is intended to provide a strong graduate level course of study related to specific fields in education. Endorsement Preparation

Special Education

The Special Educator Endorsement program is designed to provide comprehensive training and experience for teachers of learners with disabilities, which will lead to a special education endorsement. This is a cohort based, graduate program.

Graduate ESOL

This course of study is a TSPC-approved program for those seeking an endorsement in English for Speakers of Other Languages.

Important Note for Graduate Students

If the student has received a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution and wishes to enroll in more than eight credit hours of undergraduate or graduate courses offered by the University, the student must file an Application for Admission. The student must request that an official transcript be sent to the Office of Admissions from the college granting the bachelor's degree as well as official transcripts showing any post-baccalaureate work. The student must list all colleges attended on the application. Admission as a post-baccalaureate student, however, does not constitute acceptance as a candidate for a master's degree.
