VOIP POLICY

The Office of Information Technology will **only** consider Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) technology if there is no present infrastructure for analog or digital services, *and* it is unachievable and unfeasible for that infrastructure to be put in place.

The requesting party will pay for all installation costs, including, but not limited to, hardware, software, fiber, trenching and labor. Only after careful consideration and cost evaluation by Facilities and Planning and the Information Technology Department will the project be approved.

In addition to the installation charges above, there will also be a \$200 charge for each telephone number used. The requesting party will also cover the cost of all telephones sets, monthly charges (if applicable) and long distance charges.
