**Middle Level/High School Authorization
Course Requirements & Schedule**

A single authorization (Early Childhood/Elementary or Middle Level/High School) requires the completion of 32-36 quarter credit hours of combined course work, field experiences and a practicum. A dual authorization (Early Childhood/Elementary and Middle Level/High School) requires the completion of an additional 11 to 15 quarter credit hours.
