General provisions: Read Carefully

1. Students **must** have the Financial Aid Office at your host school sign this form first.
2. Send or fax the **signed** form **and** a copy of your registration at your host school to Eastern Oregon University Financial Aid Office. (541)-962-3661
3. Students will be enrolled at **both** Eastern Oregon University and the host institution.
4. Courses that are 100 level or higher are eligible for financial aid. There may be exceptions **upon request**: For example: Math 095.
5. It is the student's responsibility to report changes in enrollment and either school to EOU.
6. It is the student's responsibility to check with their advisor to ensure that **ALL** classes taken at the host school count toward their degree program.
7. It will be the student's responsibility to pay the host school.
8. ***It will be the student's responsibility to have an official transcript from the host sent to EOU at the end of each term.***

I authorize Eastern Oregon University and the host institution to share information about me regarding Financial Aid, grades, admissions and related academic issues. This sharing of my information may take place electronically via the Oregon Financial Aid Exchange (OFAX). I understand the agreement and agree to the conditions listed above.

The policies of the home institution will be in place in cases of refund/repayment due to withdrawal from courses.
