The Smith River Watershed Council in Reedsport, Oregon, is seeking applications for the Coordinator position to manage its 501(c) (3) business, annual operating budget of approximately \$50,000.00 and a project budget of approximately \$200,000.00.

The Council was founded in 2004 to repair and monitor the health of the Smith River watershed and its fish and wildlife resources. We seek to restore salmon runs, improve water quality and achieve a healthy watershed and strong community. We work to partner with landowners within the watershed for the benefit of the landowner, the watershed and the community.

The successful candidate must be able to:

- Work independently and effectively with a Board of Directors and with a wide diversity of stakeholders, project contractors and staff.
- Manage the Councils day to day business activities that include but are not limited to fiscal accounting, personnel management, grant development and contract management, marketing and product development, business relationships and public outreach.
- Must have a Bachelors degree or equivalent experience in a related field
- Must have an understanding of watershed restoration and ecology.
- Must be able to work in both office and outdoor settings and be available for evening meetings and occasional weekend events.
- Outdoor work may include physically demanding activities such as walking and hiking in rough terrain.
- Must have a valid Oregon driver's license and personal vehicle that is able to be driven to project locations.
- Must reside in or close to the Smith River watershed.

Salary and compensation to be competitive with similar positions is Southwest Oregon.

Currently this is a half time position but could be worked full time from the onset provided that the successful candidate is able to secure more administrative funds

within the first year. A primary task will be to seek out administrative funds that are currently available to increase the position to full time and include a benefit package.
