ACCUPLACER PLACEMENT TEST INFORMATION

Hello and welcome to Eastern Oregon University!

We are pleased that you have chosen EOU and recognize that you are making a major investment in yourself and your future. Our primary objective is helping you achieve your academic goals. We use Accuplacer, a computerized placement exam, to help determine which EOU math and writing classes are the best fit for you.

To take Accuplacer in La Grande, please call the EOU Testing Service at (541) 962-3788 to make an appointment. If you live out of the area, you may arrange to take the exam at a high school, community college or EOU Regional Center. Locate EOU Regional Centers at: www.eou.edu/advising/regional.html

Taking the exam off campus:

Your proctor will must fill out the Proctor Verification Form (PVF) found at: www.eou.edu/testing/documents/accuplacer-verification-form.pdf

Fax the completed form to (541) 962-3820, and call Travis Paulson at 1-800-544-2195 ext. 4 to confirm the form's arrival and to request that exam instructions be sent to your proctor.

Taking Accuplacer:

Make an appointment with your proctor. Your proctor will access the Accuplacer exam at:
www.accuplaceronline.org

When filling out the online Accuplacer form, please *use capital letters for the first letter of your first and last name*. If you have not been assigned an EOU 910- student identification number, please use your social security number without dashes or spaces.

Use of notes, books and calculators is *not* allowed during the exam; scratch paper and pencil are allowed. Some math questions may include an on-screen calculator for your use. There is no time limit; the average time used is 1.5 hours.

After the exam:

Your Accuplacer scores will be shared with you during your advising appointment. Scores do not appear on any of your university transcripts. The primary purpose of Accuplacer is to help identify EOU math and writing classes in which you are likely to be most successful.
