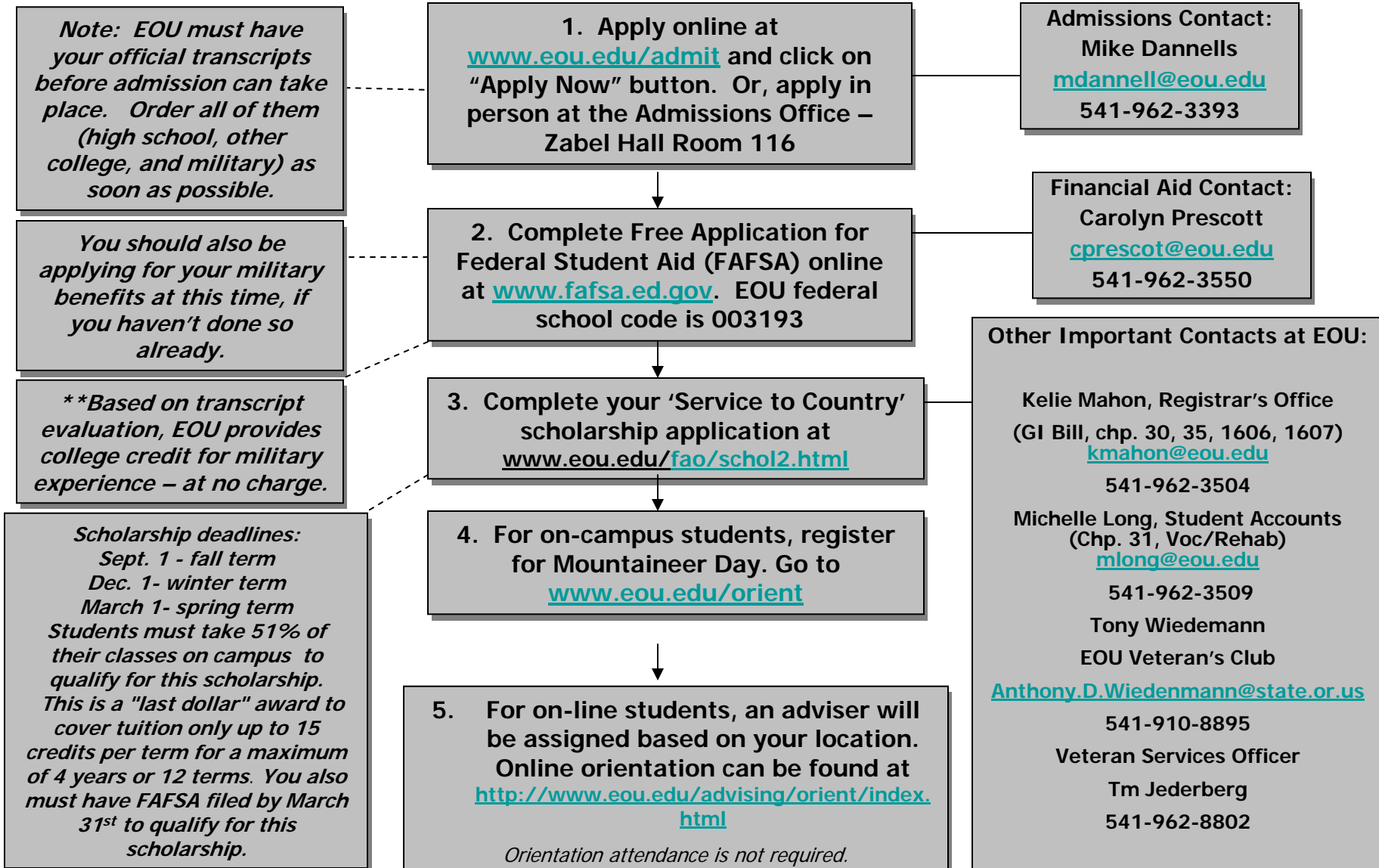

## Veterans Admissions/Enrollment Flow Chart



*Note: EOU must have your official transcripts before admission can take place. Order all of them (high school, other college, and military) as soon as possible.*

*You should also be applying for your military benefits at this time, if you haven't done so already.*

*\*\*Based on transcript evaluation, EOU provides college credit for military experience – at no charge.*

*Scholarship deadlines:  
Sept. 1 - fall term  
Dec. 1- winter term  
March 1- spring term  
Students must take 51% of their classes on campus to qualify for this scholarship. This is a "last dollar" award to cover tuition only up to 15 credits per term for a maximum of 4 years or 12 terms. You also must have FAFSA filed by March 31<sup>st</sup> to qualify for this scholarship.*
