Thank you for supporting EPA's National Network for Environmental Management Studies (NNEMS) Fellowship program as a program coordinator. This e-mail is to inform you that the NNEMS Web site (www.epa.gov/education/students.html) has been updated with the fiscal year (FY) 2010 program information and materials. The deadline for submitting applications for the FY 2010 program is **Friday, February 5, 2010** (i.e., application materials must be postmarked by that date to be eligible for consideration).

Projects for the FY 2010 program are being offered in the categories of: (1) Environmental Policy, Regulation, and Law; (2) Environmental Management and Administration; (3) Environmental Science; and (4) Public Relations and Communications. EPA has awarded more than 1,400 fellowships under the NNEMS program since its inception in 1986, and expects to award approximately 30 to 40 fellowships in 2010 for an estimated total of \$400,000.
