If it is determined that you are admissible to Eastern Oregon University, EOU can provide you with an I-20 only after you submit satisfactory evidence that you have adequate funds for your proposed program of study. Acceptable financial documents must not have been issued more than six (6) months before the term you intend to enroll at EOU and must accompany this form. Be sure to keep copies of these documents as you will need to present them to the U.S. Consular Officer at your visa interview and to the U.S. Immigration Officers at the Port of Entry. Please note: U.S. visa regulations restrict student employment, and therefore, it is important not to rely on employment for income to offset your educational expenses.

Estimated costs: Estimated expenses are based on 15 credits per term for undergraduate courses or 12 credits per term for graduate courses. These figures cover the cost of tuition, fees, and an estimate for room, board, books, supplies, health insurance, and incidental expenses. Summer tuition and fees are not included in the estimates. Costs tend to increase slightly from year to year. To help you prepare financially, be aware that bachelor's degree programs are generally 4-5 years in length. You and your sponsor must prepare to meet the ongoing costs of your educational and living expenses, not only for the first 12 months, but for the duration of your studies at EOU.
