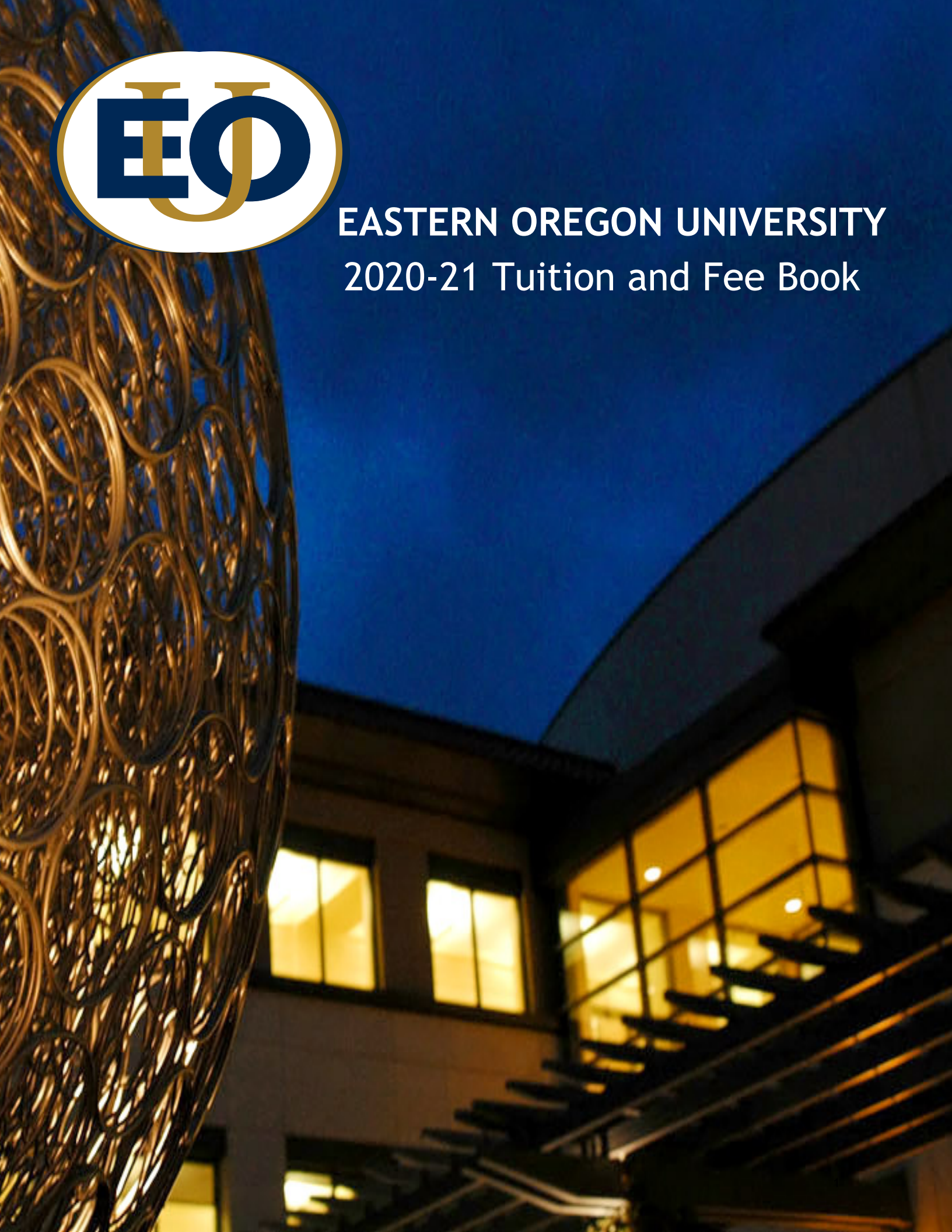

## *Tuition Structure*

---

Tuition rates for students admitted to academic programs are established via student classification (undergraduate and graduate), residency, delivery modality and credit hours taken. Tuition revenue supports university operations including the instructional and administrative costs. Nonresident and on line/on site (off campus) rates are competitive and sensitive to institutional enrollment trends and strategies.

---

## *Summary of Changes*

---

### **Tuition**

The following summarize the proposed tuition and fee changes for 2020-21. The EOU Tuition and Fee proposal incorporates Summer Session rates with Academic Year rates. As part of the implementation of Senate Bill 4141, EOU establish a Tuition Advisory Committee. The charge of the committee is to advise the president on recommendations to the EOU Board of Trustees regarding resident, on campus tuition and mandatory enrollment fees. For this purpose, mandatory enrollment fees at EOU only include Health Service & Building Fee.

#### **The base tuition increases over 2019-20 rates:**

Undergraduate resident, on campus: \$7/credit

Undergraduate nonresident, on campus: \$8/credit

Undergraduate nonresident, on campus, WUE rate: \$11/credit

Undergraduate on line/on site: \$13/credit

Graduate on line/on site: \$21/credit

### **Business/Economics Differential Fee**

The business and economics course differential fee for undergraduate courses will increase by \$.50 per credit. Undergraduate business, accounting and economic courses will have a \$13.50/credit differential. The business and economics course differential fee for graduate courses will increase by \$1 per credit. The graduate level courses will have a \$17.00/credit differential.

### **Mandatory Fees**

The Student Incidental Fee will increase by \$14/term and will now be \$295/term and the Student Health Fee will increase to \$189.50/term or by \$15/term. The Building Fee and Hoke Special Renovation Fee will remain unchanged.

## EOU Institutional Fees

Fees fall into distinct categories: Mandatory Enrollment Fees, One-time Fees, and Other Student Fees.

---

### *Mandatory Fees*

---

Mandatory enrollment fees include the Building, Health Service, Incidental, and the Hoke Special Renovation Fee. Students enrolled under the part-time student fee policy are subject to these fees at a rate appropriate to the specific number of credit hours taken each term. Fees are assessed during summer session at rates comparable to those assessed in the academic year.

**Building Fee:** This fee is established by legislative statute ORS 351.170 and allows EOU to assess up to \$45 per student per term to finance debt service for construction associated with student unions, health centers, and recreational facilities constructed through the issuance of Article XI-F(1) bonds. The fee charge for summer session is approximately 75% percent of the academic year rate (\$34). For summer, the rate is \$34 per student.

**Incidental Fee:** Incidental fee recommendations are made by ASEOU. Funds generated by incidental fees are used to fund student union operations, educational, cultural, and student government activities, and athletics. The 2020-21 Incidental Fee will be \$295.00/term

**Health Service Fee:** This fee is used to support EOU's student health services, which is operated as an auxiliary enterprise on a self-sustaining basis. There are no services provided during the summer months, therefore no fee is charged to students. The 2020-21 Health Service Fee will be \$189.50/term

**Hoke Special Renovation Fee:** This fee supports the debt service payment for the renovation of the Hoke Union Building. The Hoke Renovation Fee is \$28/term.

---

*Other Reduced Tuition and Fees*

---

EOU also has specific rates for other special categories of students:

**Developmental/Remedial Courses:**

00-99 Courses \$110/SCH Math 070 and Math 095

**EOU and other Oregon Public University employees and their dependents:**

The academic term rate for employees is 30% of resident undergraduate tuition assessed, rounded to the nearest dollar, with a maximum of 12 credits per term. Graduate courses are also available with the approval of the college Dean. Charges for Building, Health Service, Recreation, Hoke Special Renovation, and Incidental Fees are not discounted for dependents. Other fees such as lab or course fees are assessed at the full rate and no discount is provided.

**Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE):**

EOU also offers a discounted tuition rate for students admitted under the Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) program. Student are assessed at 150% of the resident undergraduate tuition rate. The WUE program allows first-time enrolling, nonresident undergraduate students from participating states to pay 150% of resident tuition when enrolled at EOU.

**High School Students:**

High School student enrolled in Eastern Promise courses will pay \$40/credit. High school student enrolled in on line courses will pay \$70/credit.

# Definitions

## Academic Year Tuition and Fees

Tuition and fees assessed to students during the academic year, including mandatory fees, one time fees and other student fees.

## EOU Advantage

EOU added a new resident undergraduate base tuition rate with the addition of their EOU Advantage rate for 2015-16. First time undergraduate freshman from Oregon, Idaho and Washington have a one-time choice between EOU's base tuition rate and the EOU's fixed four-year tuition rate – EOU Advantage. This program was phased out in 2017-18.

## Eastern Promise

This program creates additional opportunities for high school students to participate in college-level courses, as well as earn college credits and/or certificates, while still in high school.

## Fee Remissions

The fee remission is a means by which a student's fees are assessed at the prescribed tuition rate and offset by funds from some other source. Fee Remissions are essentially a tuition discount.

## Non-resident tuition

Tuition charged by EOU to those students who do not meet Oregon residency requirements and are not residents of Idaho or Washington.

## Remedial Course Tuition

Tuition charged for Math 040, 070 and 095. Tuition is \$110/credit

## One Time Fees

The matriculation fee is a one-time fee charged to all incoming students. The fee supports enrollment related expenditures for student orientation, course scheduling, transcripts and academic programming for freshman interest groups.

The Orientation Fee supports Week of Welcome (WOW) transition activities.

## On Line/On Site (Off Campus) Tuition and Fees

Tuition and fees charged by EOU for courses that are taught on line or at an off campus site.

## Student Residency

A resident student is one who fulfills Oregon residency requirements as established by OAR 580-010-0030 through 580-010-0047. Oregon residency is generally based on the following criteria: a person with a bona fide fixed and permanent physical presence established and

maintained in Oregon of not less than 12 consecutive months immediately prior to the term for which residence status is requested.

A nonresident student is one who does not meet Oregon residency requirements as specified in OAR 580-010- 0031. Under OAR 580-010-0081, Eastern Oregon University traditionally charged nonresident students the resident rate. On March 2, 2012, The Board of Higher Education approved a request to amend OAR 580-010- 0081 and began charging a nonresident tuition differential to all domestic nonresident students who either were not previously enrolled or continued to be enrolled at EOU, or who are current residents of states other than Washington, Idaho, or Oregon.

#### [Summer Session Tuition and Fees](#)

Tuition and fees assessed to students to support direct instruction and administrative costs associated with summer session programs. All summer 2020 courses will be taught on line or on site.
