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NWCCU ACCREDITATION VISIT – CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT PLANS

Following the recent NWCCU accreditation visit, the university is strengthening the evaluation of Program Assessment outcomes. This work builds on EOU's previous systematic processes while incorporating new elements to improve clarity and effectiveness.

The Provost, Deans, and CTLA are collaborating on this effort. Deans and the Provost will complete the evaluation process, with CTLA providing guidance and support throughout.

In the coming weeks, the revised Annual Program Review will be released to all programs. CTLA is available to support faculty and program leaders as they engage with the updated review process.
