*Advanced Placement (AP)

This module is an excellent choice for the student who is planning to transfer to a four-year institution and either is undecided on a major or will be majoring in a program of study with specific lower division requirements that are not offered at Eastern Promise Institutions. **All courses must be passed with a grade of C or better.** Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 at the time the module is posted on a transcript.

Not all courses listed above are offered each term. Some courses may require pre-requisites or placement tests.

College online or on campus courses may be funded through Expanded Options. See your high school administrator about this opportunity.
