The Chair and Vice Chair shall not disclose the identities of persons providing specific individual responses, except when the person completing the form has waived anonymity for a specific answer, either on that person's own initiative or in response to a request by the Chair or Vice Chair. The Chair and Vice Chair may call on the assistance of the board secretary and the secretary's assistant in processing the forms. If so, the board secretary and assistant shall also preserve the anonymity of individual responses, except as described above. Forms shall be numbered for ease of anonymous tracking.
