



Qualifying for OTP Tuition Remission Overview

- 1) You must enroll and complete the full year OTP Intro to Education course at your high school and receive a C or better in the college course ED 115 at EOU.
- 2) You must pay your EOU account balance.
- 3) You must graduate from your high school and meet EOU admissions requirements.
- 4) You will be required to attend EOU during the fall term following your high school graduation.
- 5) You must accept the remission offer from EOU and the financial aid office at the end of the school year in which you are graduating.
- 6) You must declare education as your major as an undergraduate or declare your intent to enter the MAT (master's in education) program following your undergraduate studies at EOU. As a junior you will have the option to continue with a different major and go on to the MAT program, or enter one of our undergraduate elementary education programs at La Grande, Pendleton, Ontario, or Gresham.
- 7) You must remain continuously enrolled (Fall/Winter/Spring) as a full time student at EOU and in good standing in order to qualify for the remission.
- 8) You must also fulfill your obligations as an OTP mentor to high school students each term while enrolled. This includes returning to your home district to mentor high schools students during your freshman and sophomore years and as an upper classmen mentoring freshman and sophomores at EOU. You must also fulfill the obligations for taking introductory education courses (ED 142, ED 242, ED 130) during your freshman and sophomore years and participate in the EOU education club and present at the annual CEAD Conference at EOU.
