The pre-pharmacy curriculum at EOU is designed to prepare students for entrance into pharmacy school. Although some pharmacy schools do not require a baccalaureate (B.A./B.S.) degree for admission, it is highly recommended that students plan to complete a bachelor's degree prior to matriculation. Additionally, EOU coursework prepares students for the Pharmacy College Admission Test (PCAT), which is an admission requirement for many pre-pharmacy schools. Students are strongly encouraged to work closely with their advisor when selecting appropriate coursework.
