

Reach the Peak Completion Award

2020- 2021

Students are chosen for the EOU Reach the Peak Completion Award based on their previous, current, and continued academic success. The Reach the Peak Completion Award is non-renewable and is awarded to students as a resource in degree completion, which needs to take place within one year of application submission.

Application must be for a Returning Student who:

- Carries a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA
- Need <24 credits to complete degree requirements at EOU
- Up to \$3,000 will be awarded to cover tuition and fees
- Within 1 term student must be willing to file the FASFA, for a renewal the next term
- Students may only take classes that apply towards degree completion
- Students may not change major or minor unless it moves them closer to completion

Application Deadlines:

The Academic Advisor must submit an application prior to the first day of the returning term of attendance at EOU.

Reach the Peak Information & Guidelines


What makes great RTP?

- An inactive student who would like to become a returning student
- Carries a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA
- Needs <24 credits to complete degree requirements at EOU
- Be willing to file the FASFA

Where to look for RTP students?

- Reports you can run in FAST

What is the process?

- Reach out to the students 1st, Please don't ask for Degreeworks to be updated 1st
Tell them about reach the peak, don't promise this just inform
- Send them the readmit paperwork as this is the 1st step in RTP, plus its free
- Once you have been notified they are re-admitted see if they are RTP eligible
If you have questions ASK 
- Submit the RTP to degreeworks@eou.edu & get them registered
Remember that submitting the RTP doesn't guarantee anything.
This still has to be approved by FIN AID & REG offices.
- Have them work on their FASFA as most will need more than the \$3,000 to finish

What can RTP Students NOT do?

- Students may not take any classes that don't apply towards the shortest degree completion time frame
- Students may not change major or minor unless it moves them closer to completion
- Students may not fail a course while on RTP and then retake that course again with RTP money. If a student fails a course on RTP that is needed for graduation then they will be responsible for retaking that course & paying for it without RTP funds. If the student fails 2 or more classes then RTP funds will be revoked.
