

OSU NON-DEGREE APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

This application is for students pursuing an OSU minor or who wish to take courses but do not plan to pursue a degree. Non-degree students do not qualify for financial aid. Non-degree students are part-time students and are expected to enroll in no more than eight credits per term.

1. Begin the application process at [Apply Now | Undergraduate Admissions | Oregon State University](https://admissions.oregonstate.edu/apply-choose-application)

2. Choose **“Non-Degree”** student type, and then click on **“Apply now as a non-degree student that has not earned a bachelor’s degree.”**
3. Click on **“Create an account.”** under First-time Users. Fill out the Register form with your email, name and date of birth. You will receive a Welcome email containing a link to create a password. Follow the link and log-in using your email and new password.
4. Click on **“Start a New Application.”** Choose **“Non-Degree application.”** The following question populates:

Have you earned (or will you earn prior to enrolling) a bachelor's degree?

6. Begin completing the application. When all sections of the Application Checklist are complete, choose **“Submit Application.”** Once you submit your application, you will



receive an email containing your OSU ID and other registration information. The application fee is waived for students on the EOU/La Grande campus.

7. To access the OSU Web registration system, go to [Tools and Services](#) from the OSU Home Page. Next, click on **“My OSU”** for your student services and log-in. Under the **“Student”** tab choose **“Add/Drop Classes”** from the Registration Tools menu to register for classes.
