

# Application for Admission to Oregon State University Application to Program Instructions

1. Begin the application process at [Apply Now | Undergraduate Admissions | Oregon State University](https://admissions.oregonstate.edu/apply-choose-application) [https://admissions.oregonstate.edu/apply-choose-application]
2. If you are a freshman, under **“First-Year Undergraduate”** click **“Apply Now as a First- Year Undergraduate Student.”** Choose Apply Online at Oregon State. If you are a transfer student, choose **“Transfer Undergraduate”** and click **“Apply Now as a Transfer Undergraduate Student.”**
3. Click on **“Create an account.”** under First-time Users. Fill out the Register form with your email, name and date of birth. You will receive a Welcome email containing a link to create a password. Follow the link and log-in using your email and new password.
4. Click on **“Start a New Application.”** Provide the proper response in the visa holder question based on your status. Under **“What best describes your current status?”** select the status that best describes your situation. Select the term you would like to start in the next drop down and select **Create Application.**
5. In the Academic Information section for Primary Major Choice, choose either **“Agricultural Sciences”** or **“Rangeland Sciences”**
6. For the question “Which OSU campus/location are you applying for?” choose **“OSU-EOU Ag (La Grande)”**.
7. For the question “Do you wish to apply as a Degree Partnership Program (DPP) student...” answer **“No.”**
8. Complete all sections of the rest of the application. Once you choose **“Submit Application”** you will then be asked to submit a \$65 application fee.
9. Periodically check your Admission Status at [discover.oregonstate.edu/apply/status](https://discover.oregonstate.edu/apply/status). OSU will inform you of missing materials or necessary documentation via email. Once all documents and materials have been received, you will receive information on your admission status via email.
10. Be sure to **request all transcripts be sent to OSU.** If you attended classes at other institutions or completed college credits/requirements while in high school (i.e. foreign language, AP courses) be sure to request your official transcripts from all schools attended. ACT and SAT test scores are not required, but if you wish to include them be sure official test score reports are sent to OSU.
11. **Once you are admitted, you must contact the OSU Ag and NR Program Advisor at 541-962-3612 to schedule an advising appointment and get registered.**  
To access the OSU Web registration system, go to your [BeaverHub](#) student portal. Once you are



logged in click on **“Resources”** > **“Academic”** > **“Register/Add/Drop Classes”**. You may also search for **“Register/Add/Drop Classes”** in the search option.
