Thank you for your interest in the SEITL undergraduate program at Eastern Oregon University! The SEITL undergraduate program is a 75-credit, comprehensive two-year hybrid program that combines coursework in core study areas and structured in-person clinical practices and student teaching field placements. This program is ideal for the non-traditional student, who is currently working in the classroom as an instructional aide, paraprofessional, or under an emergency license. All courses are held online, in the early evenings, to accommodate work schedules. Additionally, teacher candidates who are already working in the classroom are able to satisfy their clinical practices requirements, in that classroom. The mission of the program is to prepare qualified, informed, and dynamic special educators to work in 21st century schools. Because of the program's excellence, many students apply for admission each year. The application process requires that you produce multiple sources of evidence that, collectively, document your eligibility for admission. To be competitive in this process, you must be fully aware of the qualifications and procedures that will help you present yourself as a qualified candidate.

Admission Decisions:

Applicants will receive an email informing them of the next steps in the admission and interview process. Those not meeting eligibility requirements will be advised about what additional steps may be necessary to become eligible.

Becoming a teacher requires a serious commitment; thus, the process is meant to introduce candidates to high standards and to ensure quality in the teacher candidates for the SEITL undergraduate program. For success, work with the advising contact person, read the admissions packet materials thoroughly, adhere to all the requirements, prepare your documents carefully, and meet all the deadlines.

To be eligible to apply for admission, you must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Junior standing (90-134 completed credits) by fall term of the year in which you are applying **OR** if transferring in with an AAOT or equivalent, you must earn the AAOT degree by September 1, 2023.
- 2. Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 *If your GPA is below 3.0, provide a letter with the application detailing the factors* that contributed to this lower score.
- 3. AA Content Area Pathway or MDST pre-program coursework must be satisfied with C- or better, <u>prior to program</u> start.
 - 4a) Consideration may be given on a case-by-case basis and approved by the program Chair. Any outstanding pre-program coursework (if applicable) must be obtained outside of the program, which may lead to a delayed graduation date.

To establish eligibility:

Submit all required information to the College of Education Office no later than 5:00 PM on September, 1, 2024 to meet the final deadline. Detailed directions for each admission requirement is provided below.

Application Requirements & Checklist

- 1. <u>EOU Admission</u>: If you are not already an admitted student at Eastern Oregon University, you are required to submit an application for university admission to the EOU Office of Admissions, *prior to submitting the program application*. Applications are located on the web at http://www.eou.edu/admissions/. Official transcripts from all of the colleges and universities you have attended are required for full admission to EOU.
- 2. <u>Program Application Form</u>: Fill out the SEITL undergraduate program application in its entirety; incomplete applications will not be accepted. Should any of your contact information change during the admission process, notify Kylie Evans (541-962-3623 or krevans@eou.edu).
- 3. **Essay Question:** Please provide a response to the essay question below and attach your response in a Word document. When completed, the essay, including the prompt, should be <u>no more than two pages</u> total, double-spaced.

a. Essay Prompt

According to Campbell (2009) and Hehir (2002), ableism is defined as the belief that abled ways of being and knowing are superior. Do you think the current special education system perpetuates systemic ableism in classrooms or not?

- 4. <u>Professional Resume:</u> Please provide a one-page **professional** resume, which highlights your career objectives, education, professional experience, and other activities. Some districts or schools may require this during the placement process; The College of Education will have this on file and may distribute it for placement purposes. By signing the acknowledgement at the end of this application, you give your permission to the College of Education to distribute your resume for placement purposes.
- 5. <u>Transcripts</u>: For admission to the SEITL Program, you must obtain and provide unofficial transcripts from ALL colleges and universities you have attended, to verify that you meet the minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA requirement. To successfully apply for admission to EOU, <u>official</u> transcripts are required and should be sent to the EOU Admissions Office in addition to your application for admission, noted in bullet #1.
- 6. Program Check Sheet: Submit an updated and current Multidisciplinary Studies (MDST) check sheet -- OR-- AA

 Transfer Pathway check sheet, which can be found online. You must have grades of "C-" or better in all required coursework. If transferring to EOU with an AAOT or equivalent, the degree must be awarded by September 1,

 2024 and shall be verified by means of the official transcript. No exceptions will be made, unless otherwise approved by the College of Education Chair.
- 7. <u>References</u>: Please provide two (2) professional references, who support your admission to the SEITL Program. Your references' formal recommendation will be submitted by means of an official Google form, provided below.
 - a. It is preferred that at least one reference is from an educator who has seen you interact with youth, within the last two (2) years. If you have not had an opportunity to interact with youth under the supervision of an educator, please select another individual that qualifies as an acceptable reference, from the list below. - 8. <u>Character Questions:</u> Please complete and sign the character question form (provided within this packet). Answer all questions truthfully. If you answer "Yes" to any question, you must provide a *personal written statement of the incident, which is signed and dated by you*. We will work with EOU's licensure officer and TSPC to determine your eligibility for program admission. *This document is for our records only. You will be required to provide additional information to TSPC including official court documents as requested, and, if applicable.*

- Fingerprint Clearance: Must be completed prior to entering any classroom with children and no later than
 September 1, 2024. It is the applicant's responsibility to provide all information and documentation to TSPC when completing fingerprint requirements.

Interviews

After the preliminary review of applications, potential candidates who have been selected for the next stage of program admission will be required to interview with the Program Admission Committee in a group setting. Interviews will be conducted face-to-face or over video conference. You will be contacted by the program coordinator to schedule an interview if you are selected to move forward in the admission process.

Have you ever been convicted or been granted a diversion or conditional discharge by any court for any: (a) Felony; or (b) Misdemeanor; or (c) Major traffic violation including but not limited to: driving under the influence of intoxicants or drugs; reckless driving; fleeing from or attempting to elude a police officer; driving while your license was suspended, revoked or used in violation of any license restriction; or failure to perform the duties of a driver or witness at an accident?
