DMITRI MATHENY WORKSHOPS

Celebrated for his warm tone, soaring lyricism and masterful technique, American musician **Dmitri Matheny** has been lauded as “the first breakthrough flugelhornist since Chuck Mangione” (*San Jose Mercury News*). Matheny is an honors graduate of Interlochen Arts Academy in Michigan and the Berklee College of Music, Boston. First introduced to jazz audiences in the 1990s as the protégé of Art Farmer, Matheny has matured into “one of the jazz world's most talented horn players” (*San Francisco Chronicle*), touring internationally and releasing ten critically acclaimed CDs.
